# FLYING WITH VAPES



# FIND OUT EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU BRING YOUR VAPE ON A PLANE.

Traveling with electronic devices involves understanding a series of regulations and guidelines that can vary between airlines and countries.

These electronic devices run on a lithium-ion battery and use liquids, so it is normal for your company to warn you that you must carry it properly stored in your carry-on luggage. So you don't have to worry, you don't have to leave your vape at home when you go to travel. Of course, always remember to follow the instructions of the airline and the staff at the airport.

Also, be clear that all airlines prohibit vaping on the plane during the journey, so you will have to wait until your flight ends to use your vaping device again at your leisure. For long trips, we remind you that there are Nicotine Pouches on the market that you can use without any problem and thus enjoy a pleasant trip.

As for disposables in certain destinations and companies, you may find specific restrictions. If you follow the instructions of your airline, you will be sure that everything will go well. You should know the basic rules regarding vape use on flights.

This way you will avoid surprises at baggage checks.

You will also not be called to attention inside the airport or on the plane and you will not put the safety and well-being of passengers and crew at risk.

The reasons behind vape restrictions on the plane have to do precisely with this. You need to know the maximum amount of liquid you can travel with and other specific rules to be a responsible passenger.

Compliance with local and international regulations is mandatory, so we recommend that you check the local laws wherever you go.



# PACK YOUR VAPE PROPERLY

Always carry your devices in your **HAND LUGGAGE**. All electronic devices, not just your vape, must be properly protected in the cabin. The ban on placing batteries in checked baggage is global. Otherwise, it all depends on the airline and the laws of the destination.

We insist that your vapes cannot go in your checked baggage. The reason is that batteries are flammable, so they can overheat and cause an accident. If your device has a removable battery, transport them protected (use suitable cases for transporting batteries) and with their warps in perfect condition.

Hand luggage and checked luggage are not governed by the same regulations. So store your vaping devices well to avoid problems.

Completely disassemble the device and clean it, **WITHOUT LIQUID IN IT**. (To prevent the E-liquid from spilling or the battery from deteriorating).

As for your E-liquid. The permitted size of any e-liquid is 100 ml. Anything larger than this must be checked in. Carrying your e-liquid in a transparent plastic bag is best (bags with airtight seals are recommended).
